Stewart Udall, 1994: *The Myths of August*: "...sturdy Mormon families struggling with tragedies inflicted by a cancer epidemic foisted on them by the AEC."

Utah Gov. Mike Leavitt, Nov. 9, 2000, in a letter to the Minnesota PUC: "Utahns have experienced an epidemic of cancer and other radiation-related illnesses as a result of radioactive fallout from the AEC nuclear weapons testing in the Fifties and Sixties."
